To Answer a Call

• Lift Handset, Press Speaker or Line button

To Place a Call

Lift Handset or Press Speaker Button

• Dial extension or 7 + Number for outside calls

To Place a Call on Hold

- While on a call, Press the Hold button
- To retrieve the call, press the Resume soft key

To Transfer a Caller

- Press the *Transfer* button
- Dial number to transfer to (Announce the call)
- Press the *Transfer* button or Hang up.

To Create a Conference Call (up to 8 participants)

While on a call,

- press the *Conference* button
- Dial 3rd party and announce the conference call
- press the Conference button

To Park a call (while on a call)

- While on a call, Press the *Park* soft key
- Note the Park number on the display
- Park Range: 1000-1039

To retrieve a Parked call

• Lift the handset and dial the Park Code

To Redial a number

Press the *Redial* button

Call Forward

- Press the *Forward All* soft key
- Press the Messages button
- or enter an extension or 7 + Number

Change Phone Settings

- Press Applications Button
- Select Preferences
- Select Brightness (up or down & Save)
- Select Ringtone (Choose a Ringtone, Set, Exit)

To dial by voice from the Corporate Directory

- Lift the Handset and Dial #0
- Speak the name of the person you wish to call

Send an incoming call to Voicemail

• Press *Divert* while call is ringing

Unity Connection Voice Mail

To Set Up Mailbox

- Press Messages Button
- Enter Default PIN (provided by HR) followed by #
- Follow voice prompts to record Name and Greeting
- Change Password

To Access Voicemail

Press the Messages Button and enter your PIN

To Leave a Message in Voicemail

- Press *, Dial extension
- To by-pass Greeting, Press #.

To transfer a caller directly into Voicemail

- Press *Transfer* button
- Dial * then the extension number
- Press *Transfer* button

To Access Your Mailbox remotely

• Dial 605-331-6798, when greeting starts, Press * and enter your ID (Extension number) followed by # and then PIN followed by #.
